



How to Apply for a DUNS number and NCAGE Code (For Turkish Organizations)

According to USG grant regulations, all grantees/applicants should apply for a DUNS number, obtain an NCAGE code and register with www.sam.gov to be eligible to receive a grant.

Note that the whole process may take a month, therefore we advise you to start the process as soon as possible to avoid any delays in grant payments. No payments will be processed until your entity is registered with SAM and your institution's status becomes "active" in the SAM system.

You may start by first applying for a DUNS number from:

You should mention that your entity is a non-governmental organization or an educational institution that is applying for a grant from the U.S. Embassy/U.S. Consulate General in Istanbul/Consulate in Adana.

Then apply for an NCAGE number. For NCAGE applications or to solve related problems contact:

Once you obtain both, you may start registering your entity at www.sam.gov
